Competitors in ALL EVENTS must collect a back number from the Show Secretary on the day. The first class in each ring will start promptly at the time stated. Class times thereafter are approximate but will be adhered to as much as possible. Where a NOT BEFORE time is stated, classes will not start earlier than the time given. An up to date timetable will be given 2 days before the show.

GENERAL RULES & CONDITIONS OF THE SHOW

- 1. Competitors enter at their own risk. The Organisers cannot be responsible for any accident, loss or injury to any animal, competitor, their assistants, property or spectators however caused.
- 2. Classes are judged according the the British Riding Clubs Handbook 2024 which may be downloaded from https://www.bhs.org.uk
- 3. If insufficient entries, classes may be amalgamated. The Committee reserves the right to cancel any class or substitute any judge.
- 4. Hard hats up to the current standards according to BRC (PAS 015, EN1384:2023 provided they are BSI Kitemarked or Inspec IC marked, ASTM F1163:2004a or 04a onwards providing they are SEI marked, SNELL E2016 or 2021 onwards, AS/NZS 3838:2006 onwards provided they are SAI global marked) must be worn when mounted with chin straps fastened (incl. Fancy Dress). Correct riding dress is required in the rings. Skull caps are to have a plain muted cover for showing. Correct footwear for riding, no wellingtons or equivalent. The organisers recommend competitors to wear a back protector for all jumping classes, including the clear round ring. A BETA Level 3 displaying a Blue 2018 Label. From 1 Jan 2024, BETA 2009 Purple Label will no longer be accepted.
- 5. Spurs may be worn except in the Gymkhana. No whips in the Gymkhana. Show canes/whips are not to exceed 30" (75cms). Cruelty with whips or spurs or any other cause, at the discretion of the judges, will result in elimination. Pleaser refer to BRC Handbook 2024 Section G23.1.1
- 6. No head or body cameras are to be worn by competitors.
- 7. It is strongly recommended that mobile phones are not carried/used whilst mounted. If competitors must use their phones while mounted they must be stationary. Mobile phones must not be used in warm up arenas.
- 8. NO GALLOPING OUTSIDE THE RINGS. Competitors are requested to observe the Show's Safety Layout, Rules and Regulations.
- 9. The Judge's and Organisers' decision is final.
- 10. A Judge may not consider a pony or horse in any event that he or she has bred, sold, leased, or produced, or his/her immediate family or employees, or from whom financial gain has been received.
- 11. Objections must be made within 15 minutes of the incident, accompanied by a deposit of £20.00 which will be forfeited if the objection is over-ruled.
- 12. Competitors can only enter their own age groups in the Gymkhana events and must ride the same pony.
- 13. Competitors should report to the Collecting Ring Steward immediately a class is called. Those not present may be excluded from the class.
- 14. Competitors in jumping classes may arrange a time to jump with the Collecting Ring Steward if they are entered in another class, but please note that the jumping classes will not be delayed.
- 15. All classes are off the Leading Rein unless otherwise stated. Riders being led in one event cannot enter another off the lead, with the exception of Tiny Tots First Ridden.
- 16. Horses and Ponies entered in ridden classes must be 4 years old or over unless otherwise stated. Age is calculated from 1st January in the year of birth.
- 17. Rider's age for entry is 1st January in the current year.
- 18. Horses and Ponies may be measured. An additional 1cm will be allowed for shoes.
- 19. Please keep any dogs brought to the Show under close control and on short leads at all times. All poo bags must be taken home and not left anywhere on the show ground.
- 20. The Committee reserves the right to cancel the Show due to adverse weather or if any other unforeseen circumstances arise beyond the Organisers' control. In the event of cancellation, entry fees may be carried forwards or refunded less £5 to cover costs.

RING 1 - SHOW JUMPING INFINITY ARENA (Surface) Starts at 9.30am

Any Height Horse or Pony is allowed in any class. Rider any age. Classes will be split Junior/ Senior. Classes will be judged Single Phase. The lowest number of faults across the entire course, with the fastest in the timed section will be the winner. The course will be available for walking at the start of each class. A knockdown incurs 4 faults. First refusal 4 faults. Second refusal 8 faults. Competitors incurring 3 refusals will be eliminated. You may be allowed to continue at the judges discretion. Fall of horse or rider will mean elimination and you must leave the ring on foot.

CLASS 1: LEAD REIN/ASSISTED 🌞

Cross poles. May be led/assisted.

CLASS 2: MINI 🌞

Including lead rein

Max height 40 cms. May be led/assisted.

CLASS 3: 50 🔅

Max height 50 cms. No back rails or fillers.

CLASS 4: 60 🔅

Max height 60 cms. No fillers

CLASS 5: HORSE & HOUND

60 cms for Horses and cross poles for Hounds

Horse and Rider jumps first, then dismount and rider continues on foot with Hound to finish. Handler to wait in ring to take horse on dismount

CLASS 6: 70 🔅

70 cms. Fences may go up 5cms in the second phase.

CLASS 7: 80 🔅

80 cms. Fences may go up 5cms in the second phase.

CLASS 8: 90 🔅

90 cms. Fences may go up 5cms in the second phase.

CLASS 9: CHASE ME CHARLIE

Starting height 60 cms. Increasing in height with each round. Faults are eliminated.







