GENERAL RULES & CONDITIONS OF THE SHOW

1. Competitors enter at their own risk. The Organisers cannot be responsible for any accident, loss or injury to any animal, competitor, their assistants, property or spectators however caused.
2. Classes are judged according to the British Riding Clubs Handbook 2025 which may be downloaded from <https://www.bhs.org.uk>
3. If insufficient entries, classes may be amalgamated. The Committee reserves the right to cancel any class or substitute any judge.
4. Hard hats up to the current standards according to BRC (PAS 015, EN1384:2023 provided they are BSI Kitemarked or Inspec IC marked, ASTM F1163:2004a or 04a onwards provided they are SEI marked, SNELL E2016 or 2021 onwards, AS/NZS 3838:2006 onwards provided they are SAI global marked) must be worn when mounted with chin straps fastened (incl. Fancy Dress). Correct riding dress is required in the rings. Skull caps are to have a plain muted cover for showing. Correct footwear for riding, no wellingtons or equivalent. The organisers recommend competitors to wear a back protector for all jumping classes, including the clear round ring. A BETA Level 3 displaying a Blue 2018 Label. From 1 Jan 2024, BETA 2009 Purple Label will no longer be accepted.
5. Show canes/whips are not to exceed 30" (75cms). Cruelty with whips or spurs or any other cause, at the discretion of the judges, will result in elimination. Please refer to BRC Handbook 2024 Section G23.1.1
6. No head or body cameras are to be worn by competitors.
7. It is strongly recommended that mobile phones are not carried/used whilst mounted. If competitors must use their phones while mounted they must be stationary. Mobile phones must not be used in warm up arenas.
8. NO GALLOPING OUTSIDE THE RINGS. Competitors are requested to observe the Show's Safety Layout, Rules and Regulations.
9. The Judge's and Organisers' decision is final.
10. A Judge may not consider a pony or horse in any event that he or she has bred, sold, leased, or produced, or his/her immediate family or employees, or from whom financial gain has been received.
11. Objections must be made within 15 minutes of the incident, accompanied by a deposit of £20.00 which will be forfeited if the objection is over-ruled.
12. Competitors can only enter their own age groups in the Gymkhana events and must ride the same pony.
13. Competitors should report to the Collecting Ring Steward immediately a class is called. Those not present may be excluded from the class.
14. Competitors in jumping classes may arrange a time to jump with the Collecting Ring Steward if they are entered in another class, but please note that the jumping classes will not be delayed.
15. Horses and Ponies entered in ridden classes must be 4 years old or over unless otherwise stated. Age is calculated from 1st January in the year of birth.
16. Rider's age for entry is 1st January in the current year.
17. Horses and Ponies may be measured. An additional 1cm will be allowed for shoes.
18. Please keep any dogs brought to the Show under close control and on short leads at all times. All poo bags must be taken home and not left anywhere on the show ground.
19. The Committee reserves the right to cancel the Show due to adverse weather or if any other unforeseen circumstances arise beyond the Organisers' control. In the event of cancellation, entry fees may be carried forwards or refunded less £5 to cover costs.

VHS Regional Final qualification. All competitors placed 1st to 4th in each age category will qualify for the corresponding class at VHS Regional Finals. Members must carry their cards in the ring and have their showing card signed by the judge in the ring as proof of qualification. Non-members will receive a red qualification card which can be exchanged for signed showing card when applying for VHS membership. This MUST be done within 21 days of qualification. It is the competitors' responsibility to present their Showing card to the judge.

Those wishing to join or renew with the Society will need to apply for this before 1st May each year or a late penalty fee of £15 will be charged.

Regional Finals are open to members only.

All competitors are eligible to enter open classes at the National Veteran Championships, to be held at Arena UK, Lincolnshire on 29th August – 31st August 2025. No qualification or membership necessary. See VHS website for schedule which is available mid-season 2025.

SCHEDULE OF CLASSES

SHOW JUMPING INFINITY ARENA (Surface)

Classes will be judged Single Phase. The lowest number of faults across the entire course, with the fastest in the timed section will be the winner. The course will be available for walking at the start of each class. A knockdown incurs 4 faults. First refusal 4 faults. Second refusal 8 faults. Competitors incurring 3 refusals will be eliminated. You may be allowed to continue at the judges discretion. Fall of horse or rider will mean elimination and you must leave the ring on foot. Any height horse/pony.

AINTREE UNAFFILIATED SHOW JUMPING CHAMPIONSHIPS 2025. Qualifying shows **22nd March & 27th April.** Aintree Sweet Meadow Unaffiliated Show Jumping Championships are held at Aintree International Equestrian Centre on 27th - 28th September 2024. See <https://aintreeequestriancentre.co.uk> for full details. The 6 highest placed combinations in classes 2- 5 and 7-11 will qualify.

Class 1: **NAVIGATION STAKES** ☀️

Poles on the ground. Not timed. May be led/assisted.

Class 2: **MINI SJ** ☀️

Cross Poles. May be led/assisted.

Class 3: **50 JUNIOR** ☀️

40 - 50 cms. No back rails or fillers. Juniors only.

Class 4: **60 JUNIOR** ☀️

50 - 60 cms. Max 3 spreads. No fillers. Juniors only.

Class 5: **70 JUNIOR** ☀️

60 - 70 cms. Juniors only.

Class 6: **SIX LEG CHALLENGE**

The team enters the ring together. Rider 1 - Mounted (4 legs). Rider 2 - On foot (2 legs) with a chosen partner which can be a hobby horse, dog, friend, parent etc. Rider 1 jumps a small course max 60cms. Rider 1 then hands a baton to Rider 2 who sets off around an obstacle course comprising items such as mini hurdles, weaving cones, hula hoops, carrying a cup of water etc. The time starts from when Rider 1 crosses the start until Rider 2 crosses the finish. 5 seconds added for a knockdown. The fastest time wins.

Riders / runners may compete in more than one team. Max height 65cms. No fillers.

Class 7: **50 SENIOR** ☀️

40 - 50 cms. No back rails or fillers. Seniors only.

Class 8: **60 SENIOR** ☀️

50 - 60 cms. Max 3 spreads. No fillers. Seniors only.

Class 9: **70 SENIOR** ☀️

60 - 70 cms. Seniors only.

Class 10: **80 OPEN** ☀️

Max 80cms. Open to juniors & seniors riding a horse or pony.

Class 11: **90 OPEN** ☀️

Max 90cms. Open to juniors & seniors riding a horse or pony.

Ponies exceeding 133cms. Rider any age. Max jump height 75cms. To be shown in Natural state.

Rider not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st Jan 2025. Snaffle bridles only. Leader over 16yrs. The lead rein to be attached directly to the noseband.

Class 33: **FIRST RIDDEN EQUITATION** ★☀️
Ponies not exceeding 148cms. Rider not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st Jan 2025. Snaffle bridles only.

Class 34: **JUNIOR EQUITATION** ★☀️
Horse/Pony any height. Rider not to have attained their 18th birthday before 1st Jan 2025. Snaffle bridles only.

Class 35: **SENIOR EQUITATION** ★☀️
Horse/Pony any height. Rider to have attained their 18th birthday before 1st Jan 2025. Snaffle bridles only.

Class 36: **SIDE-SADDLE EQUITATION** ☀️
Horse/Pony any height. Rider any age. To be ridden side-saddle.

Class 37: **SHOW PONY** ★☀️
Ponies not exceeding 148cms. Rider any age. Any suitable bridle. To be shown plaited.

Horses exceeding 148cms. Rider any age. Any suitable bridle. To be shown plaited.

Class 39: **LEAD REIN PONY OF HUNTER TYPE** ☀️
Ponies not exceeding 133cms. Rider not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st Jan 2025. Snaffle bridles Only. Leader over 16yrs. The lead rein to be attached directly to the noseband. The Judge will be looking for a pony suitable to take its rider on country and town activities on the leading rein. In their individual show, ponies will be asked to negotiate small rural obstacles (not jumping). To be shown Plaited.

Class 40: **SHOW HUNTER PONY** ★☀️
Ponies of hunter type not exceeding 153cms. Rider any age. Any suitable bridle. To be shown plaited.

Class 41: **SHOW HUNTER HORSE** ★☀️
Horses of Hunter type exceeding 153cms. Rider any age. Any suitable bridle. To be shown plaited.

Class 42: **PAIRS SHOWING** ☀️
Open to any type of horse/pony. Riders any age. To be ridden side by side. One rider may be led from the other horse. Pairs must be nicely matched, if not matching then complimenting (such as both side saddle, two coloureds, two new forests, etc) To create a pleasing picture riders should be dressed similarly and try to ride as much in time and as level as possible with each other.

Class 43: **M&M SMALL BREEDS** ★☀️
Rider any age. Any suitable bridle. Open to all small M&M types. Shetlands, Dartmoor & Exmoor, Welsh Section A & B. To be shown in Natural State.

Class 44: **M&M LARGE BREEDS** ★☀️

Open to all large M&M types. Fells, Dales, Highlands, New Forest, Welsh C & D, Connemara. Rider any age. Any suitable bridle. To be shown in Natural State.

CH6: M&M CHAMPIONSHIP

1st & 2nd Prize winners from classes 27 - 30

Class 45: **PLAITED COLOURED** ★☀️

Rider any age. Open to all plaited coloured horses/ponies, including piebald, skewbald, palomino, spotted, dun, roan. Any suitable bridle.

Class 46: **COLOURED NATIVE, COB & TRADITIONAL** ★☀️

Rider any age. Open to all Native, Cob & Traditional type coloured horses/ponies. Any suitable bridle.

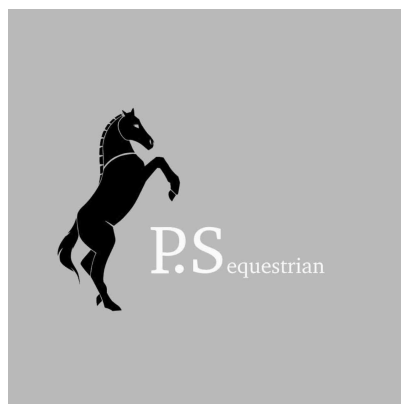
Open to any ex-racehorse that has raced under rules. Rider any age. Any suitable bridle. Horses will not be ridden by the judge.

Class 50: **CONCOURS D'ELEGANCE**

Best overall picture – horse and rider. Does not have to be side saddle. Split Junior/Senior if entries allow.



Concours d'Elegance is a costume competition (not fancy dress). The aim is to give a correct presentation for the chosen historical period, perhaps depicting a film, painting or period drama. Any historic/traditional period may be portrayed up to the 1950's. Costume, tack, rider and horse/pony will be taken into consideration.

Open to all small M&M types. Shetlands, Dartmoor & Exmoor, Welsh Section A & B. To be shown in Natural State.

Class 55: **IN-HAND M&M LARGE BREEDS** ★☀️ *sponsored by Uttoxeter Rewinds Ltd*

Open to all large breed M&Ms. Fells, Dales, Highlands, New Forest, Welsh C & D, Connemara. To be shown in Natural State.

Class 56 **IN-HAND COLOURED PONY** ★☀️

Open to all coloured ponies not exceeding 148cms.

Class 57: **IN-HAND COLOURED HORSE** ★☀️

Open to all coloured horses not exceeding 148cms.

Class 58: **IN-HAND COB** ★☀️ *sponsored by Uttoxeter Rewinds Ltd*

Horse/Pony of Cob Type including Traditionals.

Class 59: **TINY TOTS YOUNG HANDLER** ★☀️

Handler to have attained their 4th birthday but not their 8th birthday before 1st Jan 2025. Pony not to exceed 128cms. Handlers MUST be accompanied by an adult, however the adult must not assist unless the handler is in difficulty. Ponies must be suitable for the child.

Class 60: **YOUNG HANDLER** ★☀️ *sponsored by Positive Movement Therapy*

Handler to have attained their 8th birthday but not their 12th birthday before 1st Jan 2025.

Class 61: **JUNIOR HANDLER** ★☀️

Handler to have attained their 12th birthday but not their 18th birthday before 1st Jan 2025.

Class 62: **IN-HAND PLAITED PONY** ★☀️

Open to all ponies not exceeding 148cms. To be show plaited and trimmed.

Class 63: **IN-HAND PLAITED HORSE** ★☀️

Open to all horses exceeding 148cms. To be show plaited and trimmed.

Class 64: **IN-HAND VETERAN** ★☀️

Open to any type of Horse/Pony 15 years or older. This is a VETERAN HORSE Society Area Qualifier 2025. Bridle numbers with horses age to be displayed.
